

Performance during June 2022

- (i) Commission advised issuance of sanction for prosecution in respect of **20** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (ii) Prosecution sanctions were issued by the Competent Authorities in respect of **24** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iii) Commission advised initiation of major penalty proceedings against **57** officials of 14 various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (iv) Commission advised imposition of major penalty against **2** officials of 2 various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (v) On the advice of the Commission, the Competent Authorities imposed major penalties in respect of **96** officials of various Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (vi) Commission processed **1802** complaints (including **176** whistle blower complaints) during the month and sought investigation report in **40** complaints from the concerned Ministries/Departments/Organizations.
- (vii) Intensive Examination of **4** works carried out by Chief Technical Examiner's Organization resulted in recoveries to the tune of **Rs.938.00 lakhs** during **June, 2022**.
- (viii) Commission provided inputs in respect of **52** cases for vigilance clearance of officials for Board level appointments in CPSE's. In addition, references of **113** officials of All India Services and Central Services were considered for vigilance clearance in matters of empanelment, promotion etc. and inputs provided by the Commission.
- (ix) **58** officers were considered for appointment/empanelment/extension as full/part time CVOs in various organizations and recommendations were given by the Commission.
